

# SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Access to the swimming pool is strictly reserved for campsite guests - They must comply with the internal regulations.

## 1 – Pool capacity : 168 people in the large pool

Consequently, in the event of high attendance, access to the pool may be temporarily suspended by campsite staff.

## 2 – Opening hours

The campsite swimming pool is open from May to September, from 10am to 8pm. Management reserves the right to change opening hours or close the pool for reasons including weather, technical issues, hygiene or safety.

## 3 – User conduct and behaviour

Swimwear (Lycra briefs) must be worn and users must be dressed modestly.

For hygiene and safety reasons, only clothing designed exclusively for swimming, which is fitted and short, is permitted: one-piece or two-piece swimsuits, swim briefs or short swim shorts.

Any act or behaviour that may be considered indecent, immoral, disruptive to other bathers, or detrimental to the good order and cleanliness of the establishment is strictly prohibited. Such behaviour will result in immediate expulsion from the pool.

It is prohibited to use audio devices without headphones or to take photographs without the consent of the persons concerned.

## 4 – Hygiene

Animals are strictly prohibited within the aquatic area. Visitors must use the footbath and shower when entering and leaving the pool. Shoes are prohibited within the aquatic area – there is a designated area outside where they can be left.

Access to the pools is prohibited for people with illnesses whose external effects may cause discomfort or contagion to others, as well as for people who are obviously unclean. Access is also prohibited for people with respiratory or digestive symptoms.

Only young children who are 'clean' or equipped with special swimming nappies are allowed to swim.

It is forbidden to eat (including chewing gum), drink or smoke within the aquatic area.

No rubbish may be thrown on the ground.

All bathers must ensure that the aquatic area is kept tidy and clean.

## 5 – Responsibility and supervision

Access to the swimming pool is free and strictly reserved for guests staying at the campsite, who must comply with the internal rules. The swimming pool is not supervised. Minors must be accompanied by their parents, who are solely responsible for supervising them. The management cannot be held responsible in the event of an accident.

## 6 – Safety

For their own safety, pool users are asked to comply with the rules and regulations.

It is forbidden to :

- disturb other users with noisy, dangerous or immoral games or behaviour,
- push or throw people standing on the poolside into the water,
- running, shouting, diving, throwing water, or pretending to drown,
- playing ball, or using any objects that could disturb the peace and quiet of other bathers,
- climbing fences or barriers of any kind.

## 7 – Respect for facilities

It is forbidden to damage the facilities and equipment. Any damage or breakages will be repaired at the expense of the offenders.

## 8 – Penalties

Offenders of these provisions may be excluded from the swimming pool at any time by staff.

## 9 – Lost property

The campsite is not insured against the loss or theft of jewellery, valuables or cash, even if left in the care of staff. Users are advised not to bring any valuables with them. Lost property must be handed in and/or claimed at the campsite reception.
